International Eco Club Student Chapter (IECSC)

Important Guidelines to Establish IECSC

- Application Form in the prescribed format to establish IECSC at Colleges and Universities forwarded by the Head of Institution will be received throughout the year.
- To start IECSC at Colleges and Universities, a minimum strength of 100 Students members and three Staff coordinators are mandatory.
- Any student of full time/part-time course (B.Sc./M.Sc., B.E./B.Tech./B.Pharm./M.E./M.Tech./M.Pharm./ M.Phil./Ph.D.) is eligible to become member in IECSC.
- Membership fee for Arts College: Rs.300/- for I year UG students that is valid upto 3 years. In case of II and III year students, it is Rs.200/- and Rs.100/-; respectively. For PG students, Rs.200/- for 2 year course and Rs.300/- for MCA and other courses.
- Membership fee for Engineering College: Rs.400/- for I year UG students that is valid upto 4 years. In case of II, III and IV year students, it is Rs.300/-, Rs.200/- and Rs.100/-; respectively. For PG students, Rs.200/- for 2 year course and Rs.300/- for other courses.
- Membership fee is Rs.600/-, Rs.800/-, Rs.1500/- and Rs.2500/- per faculty for 3 years, 5 years, 10 years and life-time; respectively.
- Each IECSC should have President, Vice-President, Secretary, Joint- Secretary, Treasurer and five Executive committee members among student members.
- IECSC can conduct Conferences, Seminars, Workshops, Student Technical Symposium, Distinguished lecture programme, Environment day celebration, Ozone day celebration, Project model exhibition, Awareness programmes on Environmental pollution, Biodiversity and Natural resources conservation and etc. with the financial support of the Foundation.
- Best IECSC will be rewarded with a cash award of Rs.25,000/- along with a shield and memento for their outstanding contribution based on number of programmes conducted.
- Wide publicity of awareness programmes conducted and report of each programme by the IECSC will be published *via* NSF Newsletter/Magazines etc. periodically.
- Student members of IECSC can get financial assistance for innovative projects every year which is scrutinized by the Subject Expert committee with a maximum amount of Rs.10000/-
- Student members can get free subscription to NSF journals/Newsletter/Magazines and publish their research findings and general articles with zero processing fee.
- Outstanding student members can get technical mentorship from eminent Professors and Scientists in Universities and Research Organizations across the world.
- Student members who need the technical support in doing Mini / Major projects, NSF will assist them with a technical expertise.
- Since NSF is signed MoU with Indian Forest Department, if student members required medicinal, herbal, rare, endangered and economically important plants and insects for their project work, NSF will arrange to give it.
- Fifty percent registration fees could be waived if NSF is conducting conferences, seminars, workshops including summer training camp.

- NSF is to promote R&D work having social relevance, significance and usefulness to our Country in terms of environmental protection and nature conservation.
- The Students and Guides / Supervisors seeking for financial support to carry out the ‘Student Project Scheme’ should be a member of the ‘International Eco Club Student Chapter’ and the Institution should be enrolled with the Nature Science Foundation.
- Students of U.G/P.G Engineering / Science / Medicine / Agriculture / Veterinary / Social Science are eligible to apply for the ‘Student Project Scheme’.
- Major area of research may be in fields such as Agriculture, Environmental Sciences, Physical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Veterinary Sciences, Medical Sciences, Social Sciences and Engineering and Technology.
- A maximum amount of Rs.25,000/- will be given per project.
- Student Project Scheme may be applied throughout the year
- The project duration should be six months only
